

CONSTRUCTORS RULES

2017

Constructors, Associated Trades and All Comers Team Championship Rules

The competition will be run in conjunction with BFTA Grand Prix Series.

An application to enter the competition implies acceptance of these rules.

1. Each team shall consist of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 nominated members. Team members must be notified to the BFTA Competition Manager at least 7 days prior to the first Grand Prix of the year.

There are no entry restrictions for teams (except rule 5). Teams can be from constructors, associated trade, clubs, regions, friendship groups etc.

2. Shooters may only shoot for one team throughout the same season.
3. Team Points for each round of the GP series will be awarded as follows:
 - For each team member their points score will be the same as their percentage.
 - The team points score will be the total of the 3 highest team members' point scores.
4. Best 6 team scores from the 8 rounds to count towards the overall result.
5. There will be two leagues*:
 - League 1 – any member of the team is an AA grade shooter.
 - League 2 – no member of the team is an AA grade shooter.

*Only if there are sufficient team entries: at least 5 teams per league. If there are insufficient teams entered then there will be only one league.

6. Medals will be awarded for winners and runners-up in each league. In the event of an overall tie at the end of the final round a shoot-off, between one-member of each of the tied teams, shall be used to decide placements.
7. In the event of any dispute not covered by these rules, the decision of the current BFTA Competition Manager must be final.
